Prayers for Your Loved Ones

Colossians 1:9-10 – I pray that my loved one is filled with the knowledge of Your will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding, so that they walk worthy of You, Lord, fully pleasing You, bearing fruit in every good work and growing in the knowledge of You. (HCSB)

Colossians 1:11-12 – I pray that my loved one is strengthened with all power, according to Your glorious might, for all endurance and patience, with joy giving thanks to You, Father, who has enabled them to share in the saints' inheritance in the light. (HCSB)

Colossians 1:13-14 – I pray that You, God, deliver my loved one from the power of darkness and translate them into the Kingdom of Your dear Son in whom they have redemption through His blood and the forgiveness of sins. (KJV)

Colossians 4:12 – I pray that my loved one stands perfect and complete in all the will of God. (KJV)

Daniel 1:17, 20 – I pray that You, God, give my loved one knowledge and skill in all learning and wisdom and help them with understanding. And in all matters of wisdom and understanding, they are ten times wiser than all their peers. (KJV)

Deuteronomy 31:6 – I pray that my loved one is strong and of good courage, they do not fear, they are not afraid; for You, Lord God go with them; and You will not fail them, nor forsake them. (KJV)

Ephesians 1:17-19 – I pray that You, God, give my loved one the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of You, let the eyes of their understanding be enlightened; that they may know what is the hope of Your calling, what are the riches of the glory of Your inheritance in the saints, and what is the exceeding greatness of Your power toward them, as they believe, according to the working of Your mighty power. (NKJV)

Ephesians 3:16-19 – I pray that my loved one is strengthened with might through Your Spirit in their inner man, that You, Christ, would dwell in their hearts through faith; that they, being rooted and grounded in love, may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and depth and height - to know Your love which passes knowledge; that they may be filled with all the fullness of You, God. (NKJV)

Ephesians 6:1-3 – I pray that my daughter/son obeys their parents in the Lord for this is right and they honor their father and mother; and it is well with them and they live long on the earth. (NKJV)

Ephesians 4:29 – I pray that no foul language comes from my loved one's mouth, but only what is good for building up someone in need, so that it gives grace to those who hear. (HCSB)

Galatians 6:9 – I pray that my loved one does not get tired of doing good, and they reap at the proper time because they don't give up. (NKJV)

Isaiah 1:19 – I pray that my loved one is willing and obedient and eats the good of the land. (KJV)

Isaiah 41:10 – I pray that my loved one does not fear, for You, God, are with them. They are not afraid, for You, strengthen them; You help them and hold them up with Your righteous right hand. (HCSB)

Isaiah 40:29, 31 – I pray that You, Lord, give power to my loved one and increase their strength, as they wait upon You, Lord, they shall renew their strength; they will mount up with wings like eagles; they will run and not be weary; they shall walk and not faint. (KJV)

James 1:5 – I pray that You, Lord, give my loved one wisdom liberally for every decision in life, and that they know right from wrong. (KJV)

Jeremiah 29:11 – I thank You, Lord, that You think thoughts of peace towards my loved one. You don't have evil thoughts toward them; and You are giving them a future and a hope. (NKJV)

Luke 10:27 – I pray that my loved one loves You, the Lord their God, with all their heart, all their soul, all their strength and all their mind. (NKJV)

Matthew 6:10 – I pray that Your will be done in my loved one's life. (KJV)

Matthew 6:13 – I pray that You, Lord, deliver my loved one from evil. (KJV)

Philippians 1:6 – I pray and am confident of this very thing, that You who have begun a good work in my loved one will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ. (NKJV)

Philippians 4:6-7 – I pray that my loved one doesn't worry about anything, but in everything by prayer and petition with thankfulness, they let their requests be made know unto You, God. And Your peace which surpasses every thought, guards their hearts and minds in Christ Jesus. (HCSB)

Proverbs 1:8 – I pray that my daughter/son listens to their father's instruction, and they don't reject their mother's teaching. (HCSB)

Proverbs 3:5-6 – I pray that my loved one trusts in You, Lord, with all their heart, and they do not lean on their own understanding; in all their ways they acknowledge You, God, and You direct their paths. (NKJV)

Psalms 91:11 – I pray that You, God, give Your angels orders concerning my loved one, to protect them in all their ways. (HCSB)

Psalms 119:1 – I pray that my loved one is blessed and undefiled in the way and walks in Your laws. (KJV)

Psalms 119:9, 105 – I pray that my loved one keeps their way pure by keeping Your Word, for Your Word is a lamp for their feet and a light for their path. (HCSB)

Psalms 140:1 – I pray that You, O Lord, deliver my loved one; and preserve them from the violent man. (KJV)

Romans 1:16 – I pray that my loved one is not ashamed of the Good News about Christ. (NLT)

Romans 15:13 – I pray that my loved one is filled with all joy and peace as they believe in You so they may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit. (HCSB)

1 Chronicles 4:10 – I pray that You, God, would bless my loved one indeed, and enlarge their territory, that Your hand would be with them, and that You would keep them from evil, harm and pain. (NKJV)

1 Corinthians 10:13 – I pray that there is no temptation that overtakes my loved one for You, God, are faithful, You will not allow them to be tempted beyond what they are able, but with the temptation also make the way of escape, that they will be able to bear it. (HCSB)

1 Corinthians 15:33 – I pray that my loved one is not deceived and knows that bad company corrupts good morals. (HCSB)

1 Timothy 4:12 – I pray that my loved one does not let anyone despise their youth, instead they are an example to the believers in speech, in conduct, in love in faith and in purity. (HCSB)
